



MAY 2022 PRIMARY ELECTION SCORECARD RESULTS

Below are scorecard results for more than 30 candidates running for local, state, and federal offices representing Louisville, Kentucky residents. The scorecard measures candidates' positions on policies and issues that would improve the lives of Black people and communities.

The 3003 Collaborative invited candidates in select primary democratic and republican races to complete a 10-question survey. Candidate responses were reviewed and scored by a Committee of The 3003 Collaborative leaders with final scores approved by The 3003 Collaborative Board. The scores below are for candidates who completed the survey. Candidates who did not complete the survey are not listed.
